Commodity EXIM Report **DGCI & S, I T J Division**

1. The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns with respect to selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for informed trade decision making.
2. For both categories of trades, one commodity group is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for Export and Import Operations. While India specific data is sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C&I Database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRADE Database.
3. As regards the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years, i.e., 2021 to 2024. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade Database is only up to year 2024 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S Database up to November, 2025. So, for each commodity group dealt in this report, trends from 2021 to 2024 have been showcased where data has been sourced from UN Comtrade and from DGCI&S database.
4. In the instant report [1st weekly Commodity Exim Report of March, 2026 dated 4th March, 2026] the following two commodities have been dealt with.

Export: Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form (ITCHS Code – 1701)

- In 2024 this commodity group had 0.51% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database. India occupied the 3rd slot in export of this commodity with (2224.24 million USD) 5.94% share of total global exports in the year 2024.

Import: Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen And Other Residues Of Petroleum Oils Or Of Oils Obtained From Bituminous Minerals [ITCHS Code – 2713]

- In 2024 this commodity group had share of 0.45% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S database. India (imports USD 3206.13 million) having 13.50% share of total global imports of this commodity occupied 2nd slot in the 2024.

EXPORT

Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form classified as **ITCHS Code – 1701** which falls under **Chapter -17 (Sugars And Sugar Confectionery)** of **Section IV (Prepared Foodstuffs; Beverages, Spirits And Vinegar; Tobacco And Manufactured Tobacco Substitutes; Products, Whether Or Not Containing Nicotine, Intended For Inhalation Without Combustion; Other Nicotine Containing Products Intended For The Intake Of Nicotine Into The Human Body)** of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2024 this commodity group had 0.51% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database.



India's top 10 destinations of Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form by Percentage in 2024




In 2024 India exported **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** worth of USD 2263.94 million, decreased from 2023 figures of USD 3720.07 million. Libya (importing USD 301.50 million worth of goods in this segment from India) held the top slot as an export destination in this segment with 13.32% share of India's total exports of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** recorded for the year 2024. In second and third place were Sudan (USD 269.64 million) and Somalia (USD 244.42 million) to where India exported respectively 11.91% and 10.80% share of total export of this commodity in 2024. Over the period under review India's exports in this segment increased in 2022 over 2021 levels and then decreased till 2024.



World's 10 leading exporters of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** by percentage in 2024



Worldwide exports of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** amounted to USD 37456.64million in 2024, decreased over the previous year figure of USD 37570.86 million. The lead Exporters in this segment were Brazil (exporting goods worth a total of USD 18608.79 million) with 49.68% share in 2024 followed by Thailand (exporting goods of value USD 2352.73 million & 6.28 % share) . **India** (exporting goods worth a total of USD 2224.24 million in this category) with 5.94% share, stood at 3rd slot in 2024 of world exports of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form**. World export in this segment increased till 2023 and then slightly decreased in 2024 compared to 2023.





(Data labels signified for 2024)




World's ten leading importers of Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form
(by percentage share in 2024)




Worldwide imports of Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form was USD 32869.50 million in 2024, decreased from 2023 levels of USD 35952.66 million. Over the period under review (i.e. 2021-2024), global imports were at record high in 2023. The lead importers in this segment were Indonesia (9.21%) in 2024 followed next by USA (8.07%) and China (7.27%). **India** had 5.38% share of world importing trade in this segment in 2024 and stood at 4th slot in the world. World import of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** increased till 2023 from 2021 and then decreased in 2024 over 2023 levels.

As per UN Comtrade database the top 3 importers of **Cane Or Beet Sugar And Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** globally were **Indonesia, USA and China**. These 3 countries imported respectively 0.61%, 0.40% and 0.51% of their total import of **Cane or Beet Sugar and Chemically Pure Sucrose, In Solid Form** India in 2024 which is presented below:



Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen And Other Residues Of Petroleum Oils Or Of Oils Obtained From Bituminous Minerals classified as **ITCHS Code – 2713** which falls under **Chapter -27 (Mineral Fuels, Mineral Oils And Products Of Their Distillation; Bituminous Substances; Mineral Waxes)** and **Section V (Mineral Products)** of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in 2024 this commodity group had 0.45% share in India's total Import value basket as per DGCIS database.

The total amount of India's import of Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen And Other Residues Of Petroleum Oils Or Of Oils Obtained From Bituminous Minerals in 2024 stood at USD 3237.63 million, decreased from 2023 levels of USD 3742.63 million. Over the period under review, India's imports in this segment were at record high at USD 4010.63 million in 2022. In 2024, USA stood out as India's top importing partner in this segment with a share of 31.08 % of India's total import in this segment followed next by UAE (22.89%) and Saudi Arabia (11.15%). For, the period under review, India's imports in this segment increased in 2022 over 2021 and then decreased till 2024 from 2022 levels.

Worldwide import of Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen And Other Residues Of Petroleum Oils Or Of Oils Obtained From Bituminous Minerals was USD 23756.70 million in 2024, decreased from 2023 levels of USD 30127.54 million. Over the period under review, global imports were at record high at USD 36235.85 million in 2022. **India's** imports of Petroleum Coke, Petroleum Bitumen And Other Residues Of Petroleum Oils Or Of Oils Obtained From Bituminous Minerals amounted to USD 3206.13 million in the year 2024 as per UN Comtrade database and **India** ranked 2nd slot in the world with 13.50% share of total global imports of this commodity. The other lead Importers in this segment were China (USD 3543.14 million) with 14.91% share of world imports in 2024, occupied 1st slot and USA (USD 2725.13 million) occupied 3rd slot, with 11.47% share of global imports of this commodity in 2024. Global import in this segment increased in 2022 over 2021 levels and then decreased till 2024 from 2022 levels.
