Commodity EXIM Report **DGCI & S, I T J Division**

1. The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns with respect to selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for informed trade decision making.
2. For both categories of trades, one commodity group is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for Export and Import Operations. While India specific data is sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C&I Database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRADE Database.
3. As regards the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years, i.e., 2021 to 2024. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade Database is only up to year 2024 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S Database up to November, 2025. So, for each commodity group dealt in this report, trends from 2021 to 2024 have been showcased where data has been sourced from UN Comtrade and from DGCI&S database.
4. In the instant report [1st weekly Commodity Exim Report of April, 2026 dated 1st April, 2026] the following two commodities have been dealt with.

Export: Cyclic Hydrocarbons [ITCHS Code –2902] - In 2024 this commodity group had 0.43% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database. India occupied the 7th slot in export of this commodity with (1894.20 million USD) 4.96% share of total global exports in the year 2024.

Import: Instruments and Appliances used in Medical, Surgical, Dental or Veterinary Sciences, including Scientigraphic Apparatus and Sight-Testing instruments [ITCHS Code – 9018] – In 2024 this commodity group had share of 0.38% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S database. India (imports USD 2675.55 million) having 1.55% share of total global imports of this commodity occupied 15th slot in 2024.

EXPORT

Cyclic Hydrocarbons classified as ITCHS Code – 2902 which falls under **Chapter -29 (Organic chemicals)** and **Section VI (Products Of The Chemical Or Allied Industries)** of **ITC-HS classification**.

India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2024 this commodity group had 0.43% share in India’s total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database.

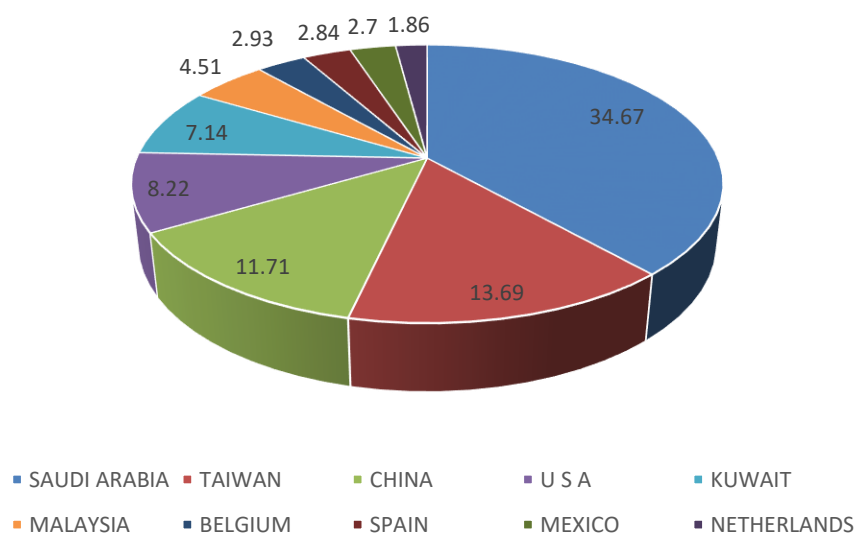

India’s top 10 destinations of Cyclic Hydrocarbons by Percentage in 2024



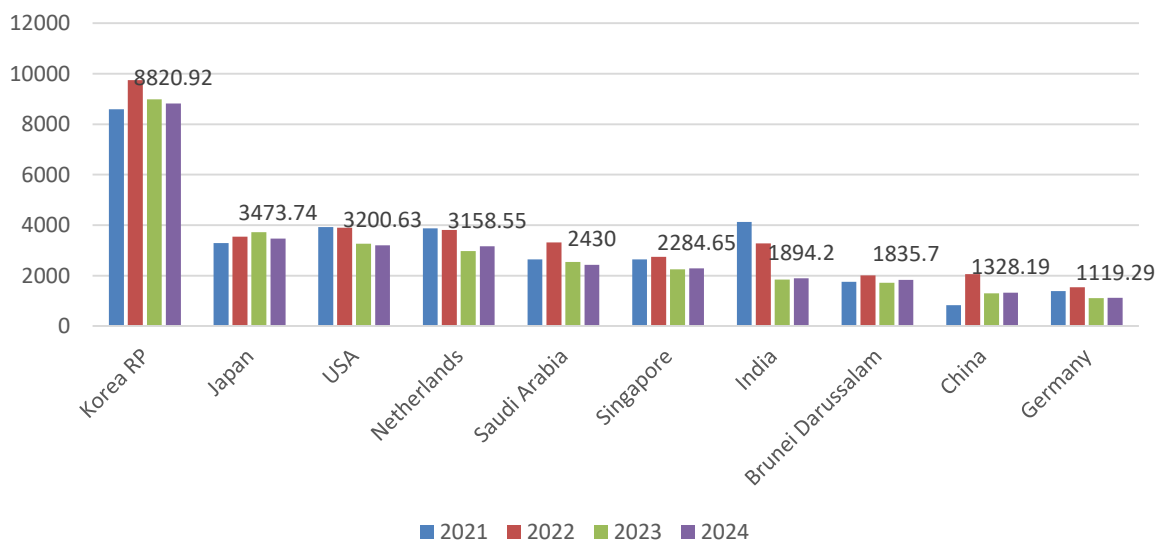
In the year 2024 India exported **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** worth of USD 3846.92 million, increased from 2023 figures of USD 3695.34 million. Saudi Arabia (importing USD 1333.83 million worth of goods in this segment from India) held the top slot as an export destination in this segment with 34.67% share of India’s total exports of **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** recorded for the year 2024 in DGCIS database. In second and third place were Taiwan (USD 526.59 million) and China (USD 450.42 million) to where India exported around 13.69% and 11.71% share of total export of this commodity respectively in 2024. Over the period under review India’s exports in this segment decreased till 2023 from 2021 levels and then increased in 2024 compared to 2023. However, CAGR of India’s total exports of Cyclic Hydrocarbons remained negative at -22.46% over the period 2021 to 2024.

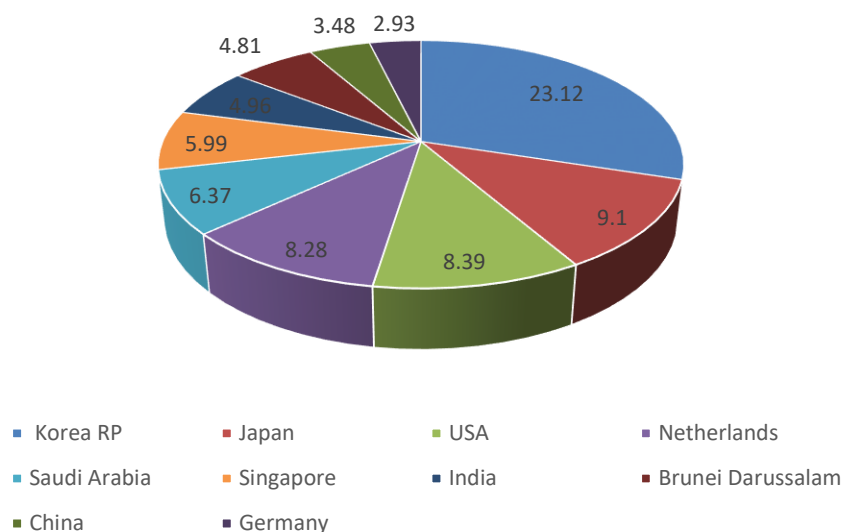

World's 10 leading exporters of Cyclic Hydrocarbons by percentage in 2024



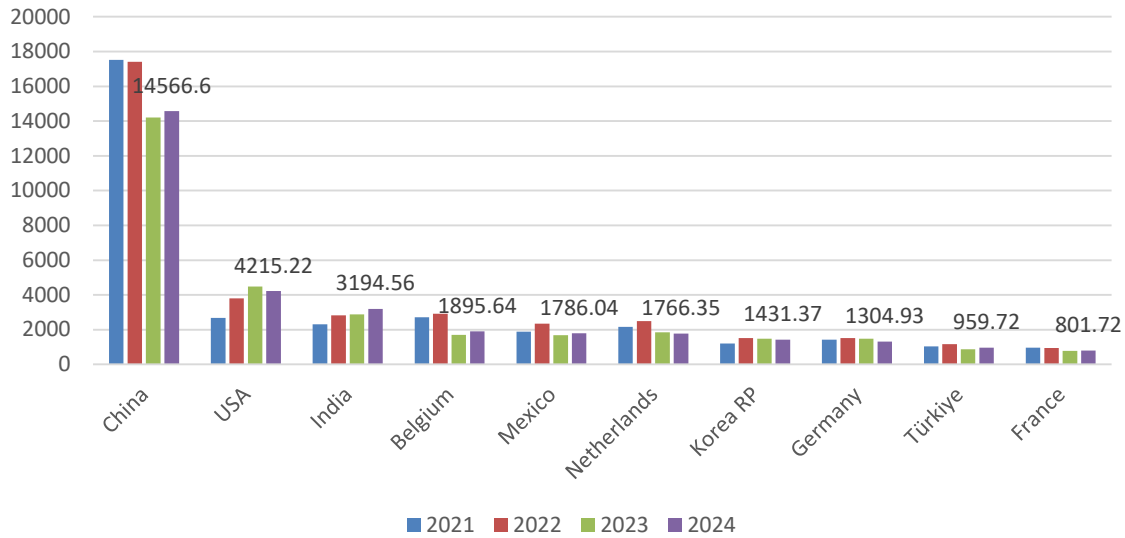
The Worldwide exports of **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** amounted to USD 38155.65 million in 2024, decreased from the previous year figure of USD 39033.97 million. The lead Exporter in this segment has consistently been Korea RP (exporting goods worth a total of USD 8820.92 million) with 23.12% share in 2024. The other top exporters in this segment were Japan (USD 3473.74 million) and USA (USD 3200.63 million), occupied 2nd and 3rd slot with 9.10% and 8.39% share of global export of this commodity respectively in 2024. World export in this segment increased in 2022 over 2021 levels and then decreased till 2024 from 2022 levels. CAGR of Worldwide exports of Cyclic Hydrocarbons stood at -4.95%.

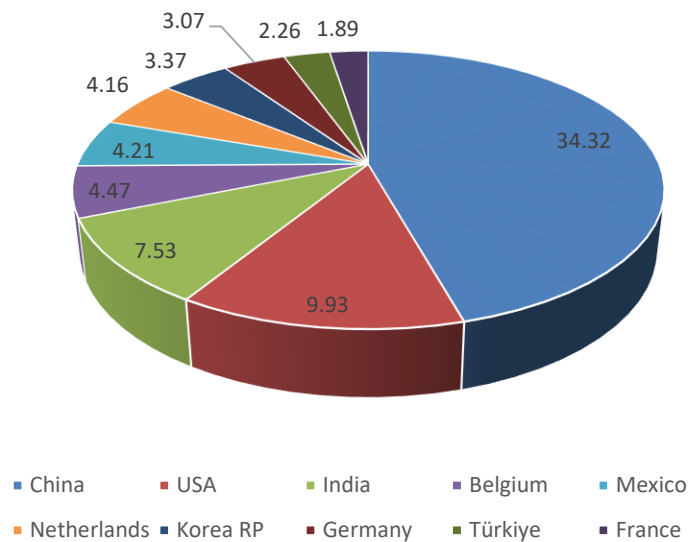

Leading Importers of Cyclic Hydrocarbons globally from 2021 to 2024 (Data labels signified for 2024)



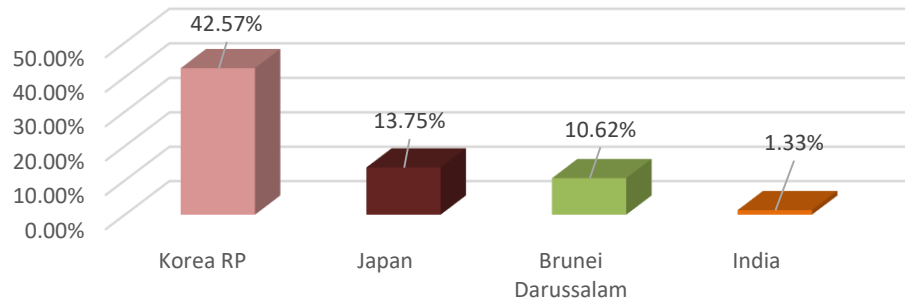
World's 10 leading importers of Cyclic Hydrocarbons (by percentage share in 2024)



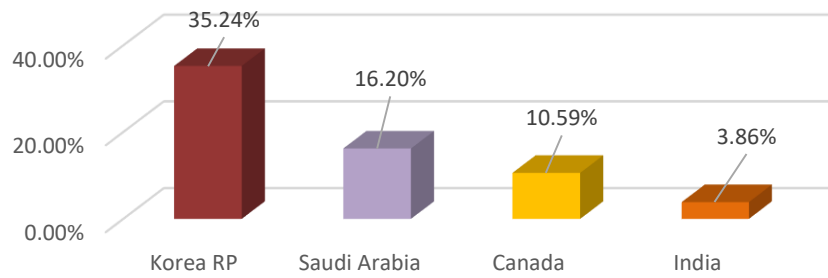
Worldwide imports of Cyclic Hydrocarbons were USD 42448.43 million in 2024, increased from 2023 levels of USD 42340.43 million. Over the period under review, global imports were at record high in 2022. The lead importers in this segment were China (34.32 %) in 2024 followed next by USA (9.93 %) and India (7.53 %). World import of **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** increased in 2022 over 2021 levels, decreased in 2023 compared to 2022 and then increased in 2024 over 2023 levels.

As per UN Comtrade database the top 3 importers of **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** globally were **CHINA**, **USA**, and **INDIA**. China and USA imported 1.33% & 3.86% respectively of their total import of **Cyclic Hydrocarbons** from India in 2024. In addition, as per UN Comtrade database, the top three supplier nations/importers of Cyclic Hydrocarbons in 2024 to India were Kuwait, Saudi Arabia and Singapore which is presented below.

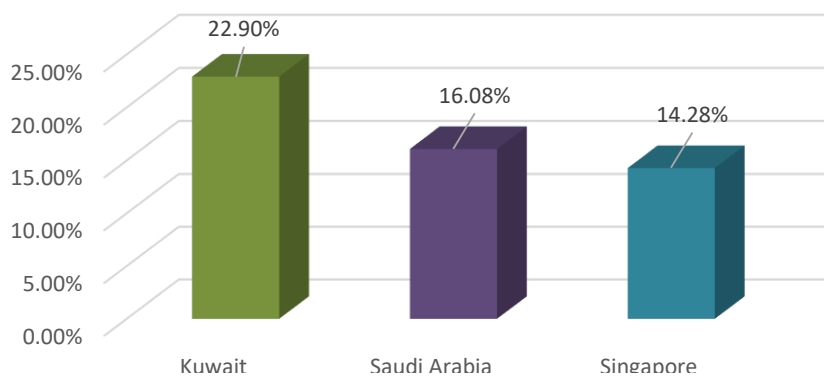
i) Top 3 supplier nations of Cyclic Hydrocarbons To CHINA in 2024 (Percentage share)

Instruments and Appliances used in Medical, Surgical, Dental or Veterinary Sciences, including Scientigraphic Apparatus and Sight-Testing instruments classified as **ITCHS Code – 9018** which falls under **Chapter -90 (Optical, Photographic, Cinematographic, Measuring, Checking, Precision, Medical Or Surgical Instruments And Apparatus; Parts And Accessories Thereof)** and **Section XVIII (Optical, Photographic, Cinematographic, Measuring, Checking, Precision, Medical Or Surgical Instruments And Apparatus; Clocks And Watches; Musical Instruments; Parts And Accessories Thereof)** of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in 2024 this commodity group had share of 0.38 % share in India’s total Import value basket as per DGCIS database.

The total amount of India’s import of **Instruments and Appliances used in Medical, Surgical, Dental or Veterinary Sciences etc.** in 2024 stood at USD 2752.51 million, increased from 2023 levels of USD 2514.91 million. Over the period under review, India’s imports in this segment were at record high in 2024. In 2024, USA stood out as India’s top importing partner in this segment with a share of 22.42 % of India’s total import in this segment followed next by China (16.92%) and Germany (10.02%). For, the period under review, India’s imports in this segment increased till 2024 from 2021 levels with a CAGR of 9.75%.

Worldwide import of **Instruments and Appliances used in Medical, Surgical, Dental or Veterinary Sciences etc.** was USD 172348.37 million in 2024, increased from 2023 levels of USD 160125.85 million. Over the period under review, global imports were at record high in 2024. **India’s** imports of **Instruments and Appliances used in Medical, Surgical, Dental or Veterinary Sciences etc.** amounted to USD 2675.55 million in the year 2024 as per UN Comtrade database and **India** ranked 15th slot in the world with the share of 1.55 % of total global imports of this commodity. The top Importer in this segment was USA (USD 41469.01 million) with 24.06 % share of world imports in 2024. The other lead importers in this segment were Netherlands (USD 14242.59 million) occupied 2nd slot with 8.26% share and Germany (USD 13571.18 million) occupied 3rd slot with 7.87% share of global imports of this commodity in 2024. Global import in this segment increased till 2024 from 2021 levels with a CAGR of 4.39%.
